With the outstanding commitment and initiation taken by Mr. Mahesh Dahal and subsequent support from NAQ, Nepalese community members are now enjoying free Yoga Classes.

Mr. Mahesh Dahal conducts free Yoga classes every Sunday from 7 AM – 9 AM at Ashgrove Bowls Club Hall, Yoku Road, Ashgrove, QLD 4060. He is a well-known person among Nepalese community in Queensland. His association with Yoga started in 2007 when he went to Kathmandu and attended Ramdev's Yoga classes for a week. Since then he has been practicing asanas and pranayamas on regular basis. When he retired from work in 2016, he went to Nepal for six months and completed Yoga Training Instructor course under Ramdev Yoga system.

NAQ very much values and respects the efforts and time put on by Mr. Dahal to deliver this free Yoga lessons to the wider Nepalese community.

2.1.6 Website Upgrade and Membership Process Automation:

NAQ EC 2016/17 appointed Mr. Amrit Khattri on a yearly agreement for the services associated with Website maintenance, upgrade and Membership Process Automation. The agreement was signed on 1st May 2017 and is valid till 30th April 2018. The upgrade and automation work is in progress at this stage.

2.1.7 Nepali Pathashala

Considering the importance and necessity of knowledge of Nepali language for our kids, Nepalese Association of Queensland (NAQ) is conducting and promoting Nepal classes (Nepali Pathashala) for kids since 2012.

Due to the declining no of students and parents involvement, the Pathsala committee and NAQ decided to be more proactive and run classes in two different locations at Kidz Magic, Heathwood, QLD and Goodstart Early Learning Centre, Virginia, QLD. As a result we have now a total of 48 enrolments in two locations combined.

Revising the policy document and forming school management committee is the next step to run both schools effectively and self sustainably.

Independent Auditor's Report

Members of Nepalese Association of Queensland Inc (NAQ)

Scope

I have audited the accounts of the Nepalese Association of Queensland Inc (NAQ) for the year ended 30 June 2017. This included examination of the cashbook, supporting documents, Statement of Financial Activity (which reports an excess of Income over Expenditure for the year of \$553.50 and the Statement of Financial Position (which shows a Balance of Funds of \$44,294.76). I have conducted an independent audit in order to express an opinion on the preparation of the accounts and the presentation of the Financial Statements.

The financial accounts have been prepared for distribution to members and related stakeholders and for the purpose of fulfilling the financial requirements under the *Associations Incorporation Act 1981*.

Some of the activities have been recorded net of income over expenses. Donations, sponsorships and other fundraising activities, once entered in the accounting records can be accounted for. This limited the audit to the amounts recorded.

It is apparent from the process that the Treasurer prepares periodical Statement of Income and Expenditure and bank reconciliations. This statement is tabled at periodical meeting for scrutiny by the Committee and members before a motion of acceptance is put, seconded and passed.

I have examined, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the Financial Statements and accompanying Notes. This was done to form an opinion as to whether in all material aspects the statements are presented fairly in accordance with the cash basis of accounting whereby revenue is recorded when it is received and expenses recorded when they are paid. In my view, the use of the cash basis of accounting as distinct from an accrual basis, results in no material difference whatsoever given the nature and timing of NAQ's
